Healing & Training Week

Equipping through healing

Every March, the ministry hosts a week for those who desire to go deeper in their healing journey with God and/or wish to receive training as Living Waters leaders. The week-long conference follows the format of the full Living Waters program, and so includes times of worship, teaching and small group participation.

By modeling the format of the Living Waters course, the participants come to a fuller knowledge of their brokenness. They receive a deeper healing—which prepares them to minister to others.

Who's it for?

The conference is open to all who wish to discover more of the Father's healing love in those broken parts of their lives. It is especially beneficial to those who have attended a full Living Waters program. Furthermore, it is important that those who want to begin a Living Waters program in their community attend this conference week. (See below for further information.)

What's involved?

Because space is limited, participants are asked to apply early (preferably prior to November 30). The cost of the week includes meals and lodging. Teachings at the conference parallel those taught in the full Living Waters program. (see the conference application and payment application for further information)

FAQs for the Living Waters Healing/Training Week

What is a Healing/Training conference like?

It's an intensive week of personal healing and equipping. Think of it as a boot camp--where you will take a crash course in discipleship, and you will learn about healing prayer, small group dynamics and group leadership.

All of the sessions will follow the same format as our programs, which includes a time of worship, teaching, prayer and small groups.

What is expected of participants?

Our conferences are experiential, meaning that people are asked to share and reveal their lives to others within the context of the small group. So participation and vulnerability and honesty are expected.

What content is included in the training part of the conference?

The first several days are devoted to personal healing and renewal. At the end of the conference, a day is set aside for specific training for the programs of Living Waters. This includes sessions on how to run

Who can attend the training?

We encourage a variety of men and women to participate.

Those from existing Living Waters programs who desire to volunteer with the local group.

Those from churches who want to be trained to start a new Living Waters program in their community

Those from places where no Living Waters group exists and who want to receive personal healing.

We give priority to those who come in groups (of two or more) and represent a team that's eager to run a Living Waters program. We also welcome pastors, church leaders, counselors and other ministry workers.
