ACT Scholarship Programme Performing Arts Scholarship 2011 Programme Guidelines

NOTE: The scholarship is only open to Grade 12 learners and individuals under the age of 25 with performing abilities who are not considered to be professional and who are not currently registered for a degree

1. REGISTRATION INFORMATION

1.1. Closing Dates

- 1.1.1. Registration deadline for individuals has been extended to **Tuesday 31 May 2011**

1.2. Registration Fee

- 1.2.1. R 100 per person payable no later than **31 May 2011**
- 1.2.2. No late entries will be processed
- 1.2.3. No refunds will be made on cancellation

1.3. Registration Forms:

- 1.3.1. In order to be eligible for auditions learners will have to produce proof of payment and completed registration forms. These must also be faxed to the ACT office on **086 622 9896**.

NB: Ensure that you are available for the final round which will be taking place in Johannesburg during the first week / at the beginning of October 2011.

2. COMPETITION DETAILS

2.1. Regional Rounds

2.1.1. Prepared Programme must consist of:

- 1 x Monologue selection from the prescribed list provided.
- 1 x Monologue selection of your choice.
- 1 x Song selection from the list provided. Entrants will be accompanied by a pianist.
- 1 x own Dance/Movement piece (Minimum 2 minutes & Maximum 3 minutes. (A CD player will be provided.)

2.1.2 Auditions

These will happen in three major cities as follows:

Cape Town:	24 & 25 June
Johannesburg:	01 & 02 July
Grahamstown:	10 & 11 July
Durban:	15 & 16 July

**NB: No parents or teachers will be allowed in the venue during adjudication.
No props or costume changes are allowed.**

2.2. Final Round

2.2.1. Prepared Programme must consist of:

- 1 x prescribed Song (Song must be performed with live accompaniment by a pianist provided by ACT)
- 1 x prescribed Monologue (text will be provided in due course)
- 1 x own choice Dance/Movement piece (You will be required to provide the technicians with the music on a CD.)
- 1 x prescribed Group Musical Theatre Piece (Will include singing and dancing.)

NB: Your programme as detailed above may not exceed 12 minutes in total. Basic lighting and sound will be provided. Props and costumes should be kept to a minimum. The following will be available for your use:

- 1 x table
- 3 x square rostrums
- 2 x chairs

NB: Finalists will be provided with the dialogue and the song ahead of the Final Round and will be required to know their lines upon arrival at the rehearsals 3 – 4 days ahead of the final event. No parents or teachers will be allowed to attend rehearsals or the technical. Parents and teachers are welcome to attend the final event where finalists will compete in front of an audience prior to the Award Ceremony.

3. DECLARATION:

By entering applicants agree to the following

- 3.1. All information supplied by the applicant is true and correct.
- 3.2. Applicants consent to ACT, as well as sponsors and partners of The ACT Performing Arts Scholarship being given information about the applicant and applicants may be contacted directly by them.
- 3.3. Finalists will be required to sign a release form.

- 3.4. The final prize is conditional and subject to the winner signing a contract with ACT.
- 3.5. The decision of The Arts & Culture Trust (ACT) and the Adjudicators of the Performing Arts Scholarship is final and no further correspondence will be entered into.
